Coaches

All coaches are required to take the free course "Concussion in Sports" and "Sudden Cardiac Arrest" annually. "Heat Illness Prevention" is a one time requirement for new coaches. Links to the courses are on the WVSSAC home page.

Football Scores

Scores must be posted online by noon Monday of the following week. Failure to do so will result in a \$50 fine.

Eligibility

Eligibility must be online before first contest for fall sports. Failure to submit will result in a \$25 fine and forfeit of contests won.

Sanctioning

Be sure to submit forms that require sanctioning by rule 30 days prior to the event.

Sports Medicine
